The spring-loaded action makes the pressure constant and even. You can even set the pole on top of delicate furniture. Each pole has a large rubber end and comes with a rubber GripDisk™ that prevents scratching and slipping. These poles also have a really nice locking action that is much faster and easier than the screw-type lock on painter's poles.
